ning and Community Development, told the commissioners that the application was back before them because, following closer examination of the county code, it was found that the basement should be included. This meant the guesthouse totalled 2,682 square feet and therefore the applicants were reapplying for special use approval for this larger size, although their representative still maintained that the basement should not be included as it was uninhabitable space.

Curry commented that, aside from the technical aspect of the square footage, he did not see any changes from last time. The Planning Commission voted 4-2 to recommend the application for approval. Commissioners Jim Egbert and Sharon Friedman voted no.

The application is now expected to be heard by BOCC on May 28.
