# Pikeview Protocol Process


\*The Protocol is a commitment by and between PPRWA members and CSU

\* SECWCD



# Water Sources and Delivery

- ★ Southern Delivery Capacity
  - ★ Near Term/Long Term
- ★ Super Ditch
- ★ Third Party Water Rights
- ★ Groundwater and Conjunctive Use
- ★ Service Areas outside the Ark Basin
- ★ Interim Water prior to SDS completion
- ★ Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR)

# Storage

- ✳ Pueblo Reservoir
  - ✳ If and When
  - ✳ SECWCD Membership process and impacts
- ✳ Stonewall Springs
- ✳ Williams Creek Reservoir
- ✳ Local Operating Storage
- ✳ Existing CSU storage capacity
- ✳ Black Squirrel basin recharge (future?)

# Pueblo County 1041 Permit

- ✳ Stormwater Enterprise requirement
- ✳ “Support the District”
- ✳ Pro-rata obligations
  - ✳ Funding the mitigation
  - ✳ Water Quality monitoring
- ✳ The Battle over Future amendments to the 1041 Permit
- ✳ POTW's
